

List of Materials for Serger Catch-all & Mug Magician

Serger Catch-All Bag

Fabric

Double-faced quilting is good. It doesn't require any interfacing or lining.

Heavy fabric, such as denim, with a lighter fabric for lining.

You can also use cotton fabric with craft fusible interfacing one piece, or use a lighter fusible interfacing on both pieces.

1/2 yard of 40" fabric will yield one bag.

5/8" of 40" fabric will yield two bags

Cutting

One 15"x 10" piece

One 10"x 16" piece

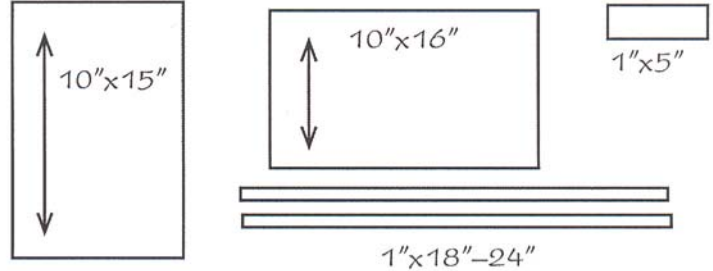
One 1" x 5" piece

Two 1" x 18"- 24" strips

If you are using cotton or other lightweight fabric, cut two of each piece.

Pre-Meeting Prep

If necessary, put fusible interfacing on the two large pieces. The three smaller pieces don't need to be interfaced.



Mug Magician

Fabric

Heavy fabric, such as denim, with a lighter fabric for lining.

You can also use cotton fabric with craft fusible interfacing on one piece, or use a lighter fusible interfacing on both pieces.

1/2 yard of 40" fabric will yield two Mug Magicians.

5/8" of 40" fabric will yield four Mug Magicians.

Cutting

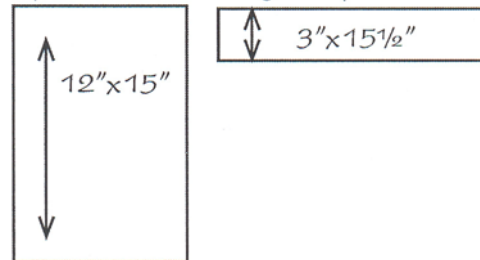
One 15"x12" piece

One 3"x15½" piece

If you are using cotton or other lightweight fabric, cut two of each piece.

Pre-Meeting Prep

If necessary, put fusible interfacing on the two pieces.



Bring to meeting

Serger/Sewing machine

Small cutting board

If you are using a sewing machine you will need 2 yards extra wide double-fold bias tape.

If you are using a serger and want to bind the edges, bring your double-fold bias foot and a strip of material to use as binding.

Thread. We will be using a three-thread or four-thread wide overlock stitch.

Ruler 18"x3" is a good size Normal sewing supplies.
