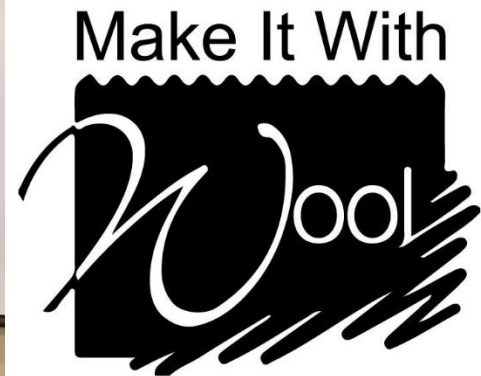

**COMPETITION CATEGORIES**

Age Determined as of Jan. 1, 2022  
*All Contestants must be a resident of California*  
~Preteen, ages 12 and under  
~Junior, ages 13-16  
~Senior, ages 17-24  
~Adult, ages 25 and older  
~Made For Others

**All California entries are due by Oct. 15, 2022**

- A \$12 entry fee per division must accompany each Pre-teen, Junior, Senior, Adult & Made for Others Entry with National Registration form.  
- A \$12 entry fee per division must accompany each Pre-teen, Junior, Senior, Adult & Made for Others State Registration form.

### **What Can Be Entered:**

Pre-teens may enter: Dress, jumper, skirt, shorts, vest, sweater, shirt/blouse, poncho/cape, or a combination of garments.

Juniors, Seniors, Adults and Made for Others may enter:

One-piece Garment: dress, jumper, outerwear jacket, coat, or cape

Two-piece Garment: outerwear coat, jacket, cape; blouse/shirt/vest or sweater with dress, jumper, skirt, pants, or shorts.

Ensemble: 3 or more garments worn together at one time: outerwear coat, jacket, cape, vest, blouse/shirt, and or sweater with dress, jumper, skirt, pants, or shorts.

### **Fabric and Yarn Requirements:**

**Send** one 3X3 inch of each wool fabric and/or 36" of each yarn with the entry form to Lynda Johnson. Also send one 6X6 inch of each wool fabric and/or 36" of each yarn with the entry form to April Ward. All fabric and yarn will be tested at State and National levels. **All fabric and yarn must be a minimum of 60% wool or specialty wool fibers.** (Specialty yarn fibers include Alpaca, angora, cashmere, llama, mohair, and vicuna.)

Travel to the contest is not guaranteed to be paid by the California MIWW Contest.

Accommodations for contestants during the National Finals will be paid by the National MIWW Contest.

Adult California winner submits garments, photos, video, and information forms to the National MIWW Competition. The Adult contestant from each state will be judged and one overall winner from all the participating states will be awarded travel and accommodations to attend the National Finals in Fort Worth.
