

Call for Entry:

The Threads That Connect Us
A Quilter's View of Sonoma County

The Petaluma Historical Library and Museum is sponsoring a quilt Show featuring towns and countryside of Sonoma County.

The theme of the exhibit is a celebration of Sonoma County in all its aspects: its towns, rolling hills, oak trees and vineyards. The county is also famous for dairies, poultry and eggs, and picturesque farms. Your interpretation may be broad and expressed in realistic, imaginative or traditional form.

Quilts must be at least 24"x24" but may be up to 50"x50" with a 4 ½" sleeve on the back. Applications need to be accompanied by a photo of the quilt being exhibited and include a brief statement about it. The quilt designs must be original.

This show is not juried, but a limited number of quilts can be accepted.

Entries open: July 15

Deadline for receipt of entry: November 12

Quilt Delivery: Quilts may be delivered to Barbara Confer on November 19-22, between the hours of 12:00 and 4:00, accompanied by the signed Release Form and the quilt receipt form. The quilts may be mailed or delivered in person. If quilts are mailed, they need to have a return label included.
